

What is WHOIS?

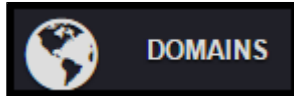
The governing body over domains, an organisation called ICANN, requires valid contact information listed for every domain name. This information is usually referred to as WHOIS information.

Step One: Navigate to the WHOIS Section of CHI


1. Log into your CHI account at chi.uk2.net.



2. Click on the tab marked "Domains" located in the menu on the left side of your screen.



3. Click on your domain to edit the WHOIS information.



4. Click the "WHOIS" link from the top of your screen.



Step Two: Edit the Contact Information

1. Make all of the necessary edits to your information.
2. Check the permission box to allow UK2 to make changes to your registrant information. For full terms and conditions, click [here](#).
3. Click "Save Changes" to complete this process.
